## Flu Jabs 2023

Flu jab clinics start mid-September at the Practice. We have ordered enough jabs for all our eligible patients. Please support your GP Surgery (and to avoid wasted vaccine).

Flu clinics will run throughout the autumn and winter months and our first Saturday clinic will be 16th September. We have clinics running throughout the week too (including early mornings, throughout the day and evenings).

We are booking now. Text invitations are being sent to patients. If you haven't received one, please contact us.



This year's eligibility is as follows:

• Those aged 65 years and over (born before 1st April 1959)

• Those aged 6 months to under 65 years in clinical risk groups

- \* Respiratory disease
- \* Heart/vascular disease \* Kidney disease
  - \* Liver disease \* As
- \* Neurological disease
- \* Diabetes
  \*Immunosuppression (due to disease or treatment)
  \* Asplenia/spleen dysfunction
  \* Obesity (BMI ≥40 kg/m<sup>2</sup>)
- Pregnant women
- Those in long-stay residential care homes
- Carers receiving carer's allowance, or are the main carer of an elderly or disabled person

• close contacts of immunocompromised individuals.

- Children aged 2 or 3 years on 31 August 2023
- Children (4—18 years but, only those in a clinical risk group should be jabbed at the surgery) Children's flu clinics:

## Autumn COVID Jab

The next COVID campaign is due to start in shortyl. Eligible patients are:

- over 65 years
- in a clinical risk group (over 6 months old)
- Household contacts of those with immunosuppression
- Carers
- Frontline health & social care workers.

### Surgery Activity

GP practices and other healthcare services are experiencing unprecedented demand. We appreciate this can be very frustrating for patients. We continue to work really hard to ensure our patients at the practice have the best care possible.



Did you know that, as reported by <u>Appointments in General</u> <u>Practice - NHS Digital</u> Jul 22—Feb 23, EPCC provided approximately 50% more appointments per 1000 patients than the national average? 622 compared to the national average of 456. This was the same for GP appointments—around 50% more at the practice than the national average.

#### NHS Help with Weight Management

It is well-known that being over-weight presents health issues, and can lead to more serious medical conditions and impact quality of life.



A new NHS service is available to patients with a BMI of over 30. Patients will be contacted in due course and invited to partake in a 10 week programme (Your Health, Your Way), involving diet, nutrition and exercise.
